



Why does TCYC need a building?

Finding ideal rehearsal space for current groups is a challenge.

- Forte! rehearsals have been displaced 30 times in the past 2 years
- Treble and Forte rehearse on Thursdays and Saturdays. Mirrors at least once a week are helpful. Finding 2 large, sound proof, mirrored spaces is near impossible.
- Bravo! requires 3 large rooms. Choreography is limited to a box shape and kids are still running into the walls. The performance segment is limited because of space too.

How will current community programs benefit from a building?

- Mirrors will inspire performers to self-correct and improve faster.
- Stage size rooms will decrease blocking time during tech week.
- There will never be a question about the rehearsal location.
